COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1274, L. D. 824, Bill "An Act
Creating the Maine School Building
Authority."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of that part designated
"Sec. 218." thereof the following underlined paragraph:

'No contract or agreement between a town or towns or community
school district and the Authority shall be valid unless first
approved by the inhabitants of the town or towns involved either
individually or as members of a community school district.'

Further amend said Bill by adding, after the underlined word
"Authority" in the 3rd line of that part designated "Sec. 219."
thereof, the following underlined words and figures: 'but not to
exceed \$15,000,000 outstanding'

Further amend said Bill by inserting, before the underlined
words "any project" in the 6th line of that part designated
"Sec. 228." thereof, the following underlined words:
'any of its property or'
