**AN ACT Prohibiting the Sale of Household Appliances by Public Utility
Companies.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 46, § 10-A, additional. Chapter 46 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 10-A, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 10-A. Sale of household appliances by public utilities companies, prohibited. No public utility company engaged in the manufacture or sale, at wholesale or retail, of electrical current or gas, shall be allowed to engage in the business of selling household appliances. The public utilities commission is hereby authorized and directed to enforce the provisions of this section.’
