**RESOLVE, in Favor of Danforth Rod and Gun Club.**

**Fish screen at lower end of Hot Brook lake; building of. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game the sum of \$190.28 to Danforth Rod and Gun Club, which sum represents  $\frac{1}{2}$  the cost of building a fish screen at the lower end of Hot Brook lake, Aroostook county, the screen being built under the provisions of chapter 48 of the resolves of 1949.
