STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Proceedings in the Probate Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 145, § 37, amended. Section 37 of chapter 145 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the 3rd sentence thereof, a new sentence to read as follows:

'If the court in its discretion does not notify the department of health and welfare, the judge shall require, in writing, under oath, a personal history of the adopting parents which shall reflect the financial status, occupation, criminal record and such other information as shall apprise the judge concerning the adopting parents.'
