**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Rancourt Pond in Dennistown  
Plantation, Somerset County.**

**Rancourt pond; fishing regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily bag limit of 15 fish or 5 pounds in Rancourt pond, in Dennistown plantation, Somerset county.
