STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Construction of State Aid Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 20, § 29, amended. The 1st sentence of section 29 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'If any town shall in any single year increase its appropriation for state aid roads to an amount not exceeding 2 times the maximum amount which it may annually appropriate under the provisions of section 25, the commission may, from any balance of said fund for state aid construction, after the appropriations contemplated in section 27 and subject to the provisions of section 30 as to apportionment, appropriate a like increase of state aid, except that all state aid in excess of that required by the provisions of section 27 shall be used with the state aid joint fund of the town in excess of that required by the provisions of section 25 for the reconstruction of improved state aid highways; such appropriation shall not deprive the town of its right to the regular annual state aid in other years; the appropriations contemplated by this section shall be united with and become a part of the joint fund referred to in section 27.'
