HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 352, L. D. 880, Bill "An Act Relating
to Education in Unorganized Territory."

Amend said Bill by striking out that part designated
"Sec. 148-A" of section 3 thereof and inserting in place thereof
the following underlined paragraph:

'Sec. 148-A. Unorganized territory capital working fund;
appropriation. There is hereby created the unorganized territory
capital working fund, hereinafter referred to as the "fund," which
shall be a continuing fund in the books of the state, and for
which there shall be appropriated the sum of \$140,000 during the
fiscal year 1951-52 to be used as provided in section 148-B. Any
unexpended balances shall not lapse, but shall remain a con-
tinuing carrying account.'
