STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Enforcement of the Liquor Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 6, sub-§ XV, repealed and replaced. Subsection XV of section 6 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'XV. To invoke the aid of state police, municipal officers, police and constables of towns and cities, assessors of plantations, sheriffs and their deputies in inquiring into all violations of law relating to the sale, possession, manufacture and transportation of intoxicating liquor, and arresting and prosecuting all offenders against the same.'
