IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Entertainment in Licensed Premises.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 37, repealed and replaced. Section 37 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 37. Prohibiting dancing, music or entertainment in licensed premises; exception. No licensee shall permit on the licensed premises, or premises contiguous or adjacent thereto, under his control, any dancing, music or entertainment of any kind to include television, but with radio or other mechanical musical device excepted.'
