HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1329, L. D. 892, Bill "An Act Relating to the Conservation of Clams in Washington County."

Amend said Bill by striking out the last sentence of that part designated "Sec. 88-A" and inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentences:

'Except, however, any person may be permitted to dig clams for fish bait, home consumption or for local restaurant use during the period aforesaid within the limits of said county; provided, however, that no such person shall dig, for purposes mentioned in this section, during any 1 day more than 1 bushel of clams. Nothing in this section, nor in sections 88-B or 88-C, shall be construed to prohibit the importation, sale, transportation or possession of clams from outside of Washington county.'
