AN ACT Relating to By-Laws by Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 80, § 83, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 83 of chapter 80 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘Towns, cities, ~~and~~ village corporations **and the governor and council of the Penobscot tribe of Indians** may make by-laws or ordinances, not inconsistent with law, and enforce them by suitable penalties, for the purposes and with the limitations following:’
