IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Suspension of Hunting and Fishing Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 64, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 64 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The commissioner may suspend ~~any or all~~ licenses held by any person who has appealed from a sentence imposed upon an alleged violation of the provisions of this chapter or of any rules and regulations adopted by the commissioner pursuant hereto. **Such suspension shall apply only to the particular activity in which the licensee was engaged at the time of the alleged violation.**'
