## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Relating to Sale of Real Estate for Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 81, § 155, amended. Section 155 of chapter 81 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof a new sentence, to read as follows:

'If the collector's or treasurer's deed has been held by a municipality for a period of 15 years, no evidence that such sale was invalid and ineffectual to convey the title shall be admissible.'
