STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Rentals of Certain State Offices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14, § 27-A, additional. Chapter 14 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 27-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 27-A. Rentals for certain state offices. Departments, agencies and commissions having jurisdiction over activities not supported by general fund appropriations shall pay rentals for space occupied by such activities in state-controlled buildings on an equitable basis to be determined by the governor and council. Such rentals shall be credited to the general fund.'
