STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Price of Milk to the State and Certain Institutions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 28, § 4-A, additional. Chapter 28 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 4-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 4-A. Limitation. The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to the state, any subdivision of the state, any public hospital, any school lunch program, or any charitable or educational institution which is supported in whole or in part by aid granted by the state or any municipality.'
