STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Motor Vehicle Damage by Protected Wild Animals and Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 33, § 84-A, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 84-A of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Within 60 90 days thereafter, the owner of such motor vehicle shall sent to the commissioner the receipted repair bill of the damage claimed.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 33, § 84-A, amended. The last paragraph of section 84-A of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed.
