AN ACT Relating to Anti-Splash Equipment on Certain Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 113-A. Chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 113-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 113-A. Anti-splash equipment. Every vehicle without rear fenders shall be equipped with canvas flaps, or other suitable material, attached where rear fenders would normally be, so that splashing of other vehicles following will be prevented.'
