#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Ernest Hardison, of Franklin.

Ernest Hardison; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$25 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Ernest Hardison, of Franklin, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1951, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Ernest Hardison is a cripple, aged 50. He has no relative able to support him.
