RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Charles Watt, of Blanchard.

Charles Watt; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Charles Watt, of Blanchard, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1951, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Watt is almost completely crippled with arthritis. His support is an excessive load on a very small community.
