STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Mrs. Vivian Dill, of Mount Vernon.

Mrs. Vivian Dill; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be and hereby is, granted to Mrs. Vivian Dill, of Mount Vernon, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1951, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Dill is a widow about 58 years old. She is not very well and is unable to earn a living. She has one son and a granddaughter (who attends school) living with her. Her home is small and the loss of income is working a hardship for her.
