# RESOLVE, Permitting the Building of a Fish Pond in Chapman.

Fish pond to be built in Chapman. Resolved: That Halstead C. Foss and Hilston T. Kilcollins, both of Chapman, doing business as Foss & Kilcollins, a partnership, are hereby authorized to build a dam and create a pond on Irrigation pond in Chapman located on Dudley brook, so called, lot numbered one (1) on land owned and occupied by Foss & Kilcollins; and be it further

Resolved: That the pond hereby created shall be a private pond, and all fishing rights therein are reserved to the owners of the said property.

# STATEMENT OF FACTS

The pond covers 3 acres, deepest point 11 feet, fishway constructed, pond stocked in June 1950 by United States Department of Agriculture, dam built in August, 1948. They desire to extend the pond to include head of dead water.
