STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Providing for the Placing of the Names of Owners and Lessees on Commercial Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 101, additional. Chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 101, to read as follows:

'Sec. 101. Placing of names of owners and lessees on commercial vehicles. No motor truck or truck tractor, having a gross weight in excess of 9,000 pounds, shall be operated over the highways of this state unless there shall be conspicuously painted on each side thereof the name and principal place of business of the owner, and on each semi-trailer or trailer the name of the owner; and when any of the above mentioned vehicles is under lease, the name of the lessee shall be painted thereon as above provided.'
