HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 414, L. D. 975, Bill "An Act to Create
the Flander's Bay Community School District."

Amend said Bill by striking out the Title and inserting in place
thereof the following Title: 'An Act Relating to the Flander's Bay
Community School District.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all after the enacting
clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Power to borrow money and how financed. The trustees of the
Flander's Bay Community School District, organized under the
general law, are hereby authorized to issue bonds and notes of the
district, not to exceed in the aggregate at any one time outstanding
exclusive of refundings, 7% of the total of the last preceding
valuation of all of the participating towns. The maintenance and
operational costs of the district shall be apportioned among the
participating towns on the basis of the average daily membership
in the community school from each of the towns.'
