STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Deposit of Potatoes into Waters of the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 72, § 9, amended. Section 9 of chapter 72 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 158 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 9. Deposit of potatoes into streams, etc. No person, firm, corporation or federal agency shall deposit or cause to be deposited potatoes or any part or parts thereof, except the potato pulp resulting from the manufacture of potato starch, into any stream, pond, lake or other body of water or water course, or on the ice thereof, or on the banks of the same where such potatoes, or any part or parts thereof, may pollute such waters. The provisions hereof shall not apply to industries licensed under this chapter.'
