# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Distribution of Antitoxins in Emergencies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 54-A, additional. Chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 54-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 54-A. Distribution of antitoxins in time of emergency. The department, with the approval of the governor and council may, for the purpose of aiding in national defense in case of war or in any state emergency, declared by the governor under the provisions of the civil defense law, prepare and distribute within the state, and sell or give away, in its discretion, antitoxins, serums, vaccines, viruses and analogous products applicable to the prevention or cure of disease of man.'
