STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 82, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 82 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be an open season on deer in each calendar year beginning the 21st day of October and ending the 30th day of November, both dates inclusive, in the counties of Aroostook, Penobscot, Somerset, Piscataquis, Franklin and Oxford, north of route 302 between the hours of 7 a.m. and 4 p.m. All the rest of the calendar year, either before or after the open season shall be a closed season on deer in these counties. If the deer herd should suffer a serious loss due to winter kill in any non-legislative year the commissioner may, by rule and regulation published in the daily newspapers of the state, reduce the open season for that year only in keeping with the herd then available.'
