STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Fees of Registers of Probate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 140, § 40-A, repealed and replaced. Section 40-A of chapter 140 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 359 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 40-A. Fees for filing warant and inventory. The register of probate shall receive a filing fee of \$3 for each warrant and inventory filed by an executor or administrator when the value of the estate is at least \$1,000 and under \$25,000; and an additional \$1 shall be received for every \$5,000 or fraction thereof by which an estate shall exceed \$25,000; provided, however, that the maximum fee shall not exceed \$13. Fees received by registers of probate for filing warrant and inventory shall accrue to the county in which the estate is probated.'
