HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 443, L. D. 1006, Bill "An Act

Relating to Qualifications for Lobster Licenses

for Veterans."

Amend said Bill by striking out the last paragraph thereof and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:

'Such license shall be issued only to persons who have been. for 3 years immediately prior to the date of the application, legal residents of this state; provided, however, that any person who has previously been a legal resident of this state and has reestablished a legal residence here for a period of 1 year next preceding his application shall be entitled to have his non-residence taken as part of said 3 years, and the fee for such license shall be \$5; and provided further, that a veteran of World War II, who was is honorably discharged er , honorably separated or retired from active service in the armed forces and-whe-has-resided-in-Maine-at any-time-between-July-25,-1947-and-July-25,-1956-and-who-has-taken training-under-a-licensed-Maine-lobster-fisherman-as-provided-forin-Publie-Law-346,-78th-Congress-(G:-I:-Bill)-or-Publie-Law-16, 78th-Gengress, shall be granted such license if he has been a resident of Maine for at least 2-years 1 year prior to the date of the application.'
