AN ACT Relating to Transportation of Poultry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 27, § 117, repealed and replaced. Section 117 of chapter 27 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 117. Transportation of poultry. No person, firm or corporation shall transport poultry from place to place within this state upon any way unless possessed of a license duly issued by the commissioner, or his duly authorized agent.'
