STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Fisher.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 33, § 97, sub-§ I, amended. The 5th paragraph of subsection I of section 97 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be no open season on fisher and sable except that there shall be an open season on fisher, by trapping only, during the month of January, 1950.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 33, § 97, sub-§ I, amended. Subsection I of section 97 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding after the 5th paragraph thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'The commissioner may, in his discretion, declare an open season of 15 days only for trapping fisher between the dates of November 1 to December 31st, inclusive, of each year. Such open season may be declared for any section in the state.'
