AN ACT Creating Beauchamp Point Game Preserve.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 128, amended. Section 128 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto, in alphabetical order, a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'Beauchamp Point: No person shall at any time hunt, pursue, molest, trap, catch, shoot at, kill or destroy any wild bird or wild animal except fox within the following described territory situated in Rockport and Camden, in the county of Knox: Beginning at the mouth of Goose river in Rockport; thence in a northerly direction to the mouth of the Megunticook river in Camden; thence in a southerly direction along the coast around Metcalf point and Beauchamp point and thence in a northerly direction to the said Goose river.'
