STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Conviction of Violation of Motor Vehicle Statute.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 136-A, additional. Chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 136-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 136-A. Conviction of violation of motor vehicle statute. Notwithstanding other provisions of law, any person convicted of any violation of the motor vehicle laws or regulations in connection therewith, where the fine imposed does not exceed \$10, exclusive of the costs of court, shall not be recorded as a criminal and shall not acquire a criminal record in consequence thereof.'
