AN ACT Relating to Closed Time on Scallops.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 34, § 108, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 108 of chapter 34 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be a closed season on scallops in all the coastal waters of the state from the 1st day of April until the 31st 25th day of the following October November, both days inclusive, except that there shall be a closed season on scallops in the waters of the Bagaduce river to a point at the mouth of said river marked by a line and bound extending from Dice's Head in Castine, through the southernmost point of Nautilus Island to the Brooksville shore, from the 1st day of April until the 31st day of the following December.'
