STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Exempting from Taxation the Property of Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 81, § 6, sub-§ VIII, amended. Subsection VIII of section 6 of chapter 81 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'VIII. The polls and estates of only these Indians who reside on tribal reservations; and the polls of persons under guardianship, or blind.'
