**AN ACT Relating to Dog Licenses.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 88, § 9, amended.** The 2nd sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 9 of chapter 88 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'All female dogs shall be considered capable of producing young unless a certificate issued by the commissioner of agriculture ~~and signed by a licensed veterinarian~~, or previous license record, is presented ~~from a licensed veterinarian~~ stating that such female was made incapable of bearing young by spaying ~~by him.~~'
