STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Fees of Sheriffs and Their Deputies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 166, sub-§ XXXVII, amended. Subsection XXXVII of section 166 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'XXXVII. Every deputy sheriff and court messenger while in attendance upon the supreme judicial court or the superior court in their several counties shall receive for said attendance and service \$7 \$10 a day; and the sheriff, at its opening, shall present to the court a list of the officers attending, with the statement of the duties of each; and the court shall determine the number necessary and disallow charges for others.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 79, § 166, sub-§ XXXVIII, amended. Subsection XXXVIII of section 166 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'XXXVIII. Every deputy sheriff while performing special duties under order of the sheriff shall receive for such services $\frac{57}{7}$ sto a day, together with necessary incidental expenses, to be paid from the county treasury, the bills for which shall be audited as provided in section 2 of chapter 137.'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 79, § 189, amended. Section 189 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 189. Special deputies in Cumberland county; compensation. The sheriff of Cumberland county shall appoint 3 deputy sheriffs, who shall serve at the pleasure of said sheriff, and whose special duty shall be to enforce the criminal laws of said county, and who shall receive as compensation therefor the sum of $\frac{27}{7}$ io per day to be paid from the county treasury, together with such incidental expenses as may be necessary for the proper enforcement of said laws; bills for which shall be audited as provided in section 2 of chapter 137.'
