AN ACT Relating to the Salaries of the Deputy Register of Deeds and Clerks in the Office of Register of Deeds in Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended, which relates to the salary of the deputy register of deeds and clerk hire in the office of the register of deeds in Cumberland county, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of register of deeds, ~~\$15,500~~ \$21,000; ~~with the additional sum of \$4,500, which additional sum shall be available for the period of 2 years from the effective date hereof;~~ deputy register of deeds, ~~\$2,450~~ \$2,900;'
