STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Recording of Death of Owner of Lands in Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 346, amended. Section 346 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 346. Death of owner and description of lots to be recorded. The agent clerk shall enter upon his record a memorandum of the death of any Indian owning lands, the date thereof, a description of the lots owned by the deceased, and the names of those persons, so far as acertainable, who are entitled to such lands by inheritance.'
