COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1400, L. D. 1061, Bill "An Act
Relating to Stamping of Meat for Human
Consumption."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the underlined word
"slaughterhouse" in the 5th line thereof the underlined words
'in Maine'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the underlined
word "portioned" in the next to the last line thereof the under-
lined words 'in wholesale cuts'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the
following underlined sentence: 'The provisions of this
paragraph shall not apply to meat or meat by-products bearing a
federal stamp.'
