STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Stamping of Meat for Human Consumption.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 27, § 188, amended. Section 188 of chapter 27 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to read as follows:

'All carcasses of meat from animals that are slaughtered in a licensed slaughterhouse and which are to be used for human consumption shall be stamped with the license number issued by the commissioner of agriculture to the licensed establishment, type and design of stamp to be approved by the commissioner. The meat shall be stamped on all parts that are to be portioned and the edible meat by-products shall be so stamped.'
