AN ACT Relating to Taking Animals and Birds for Scientific Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 11, amended. Section 11 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding before the last paragraph thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'The commissioner may issue permits to any person, firm or corporation to take, have in possession, band and transport wild birds and animals for scientific purposes. He may issue such rules and regulations as may be necessary.'
