IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Estimates for Taxes by County Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 13, amended. Section 13 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 13. County commissioners to make annual estimates for county taxes. In order to assess a county tax, county commissioners, at their regular session next before the 1st day of each January in which the legislature meets, shall prepare estimates of the sums necessary to defray the expenses which have accrued or may probably accrue for I year from said day, including the building and repairing of jails, court-houses and appurtenances, with the debts owed by their counties, and like estimates for the succeeding year, and after newspaper notice hold a public hearing thereon in the county, and the county tax for both said years shall be granted by the legislature separately at the same session.'
