AN ACT Relating to Hunting from Automobiles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 68, amended. The last sentence of section 68 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No person excepting a law enforcement officer while in the line of duty shall have a loaded rifle or loaded shotgun or a gun with a cartridge in the magazine thereof **or a loaded revolver or loaded pistol with a barrel length of over 5 inches** in or on any motor vehicle.'
