AN ACT Relating to Kindling of Fires in Unorganized Townships.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 85, § 35, amended. Section 35 of chapter 85 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows :

'In unorganized townships, permission may be obtained by residents to kindle fires from the chief forest fire warden or his representative in charge of the area.'
