STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Non-Resident Dealers in Furs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 106, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 106 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The fee for the license shall be \$25 for residence resident citizens of this state and \$100, \$200 for non-residents and \$300 for aliens, to be paid to the said commissioner.'
