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**AN ACT Relating to Non-Resident Dealers in Furs.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 33, § 106, amended.** The 3rd sentence of section 106 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The fee for the license shall be \$25 for ~~residence~~ **resident citizens** of this state ~~and \$100, \$200~~ for non-residents ~~and \$300~~ **for aliens**, to be paid to the said commissioner.'
