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**AN ACT Relating to Licensing Cats**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 88, § 25-A, additional.** Chapter 88 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 25-A, to read as follows:

**'Sec. 25-A. Cat licenses to be applied for annually. On or before the 1st day of April of each year, the owner or keeper of any cat 6 months old or over shall apply to the city or town clerk either orally or in writing for a license for each such cat owned or kept by him. Such application shall state the breed, sex, color and markings of such cat. A fee of 50c shall be paid for each license issued.'**
