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AN ACT Relating to Analysis of Water.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 22, § 121, amended.** The last sentence of section 121 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 52 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The department shall charge the average cost of the analysis as determined by the state auditor, for such examination to the person required to have such test made, provided that analyses required in excess of the number regularly required as of January 1, 1951, by the department shall be done without charge by the department to the person. Costs of such additional tests shall be paid from moneys appropriated for or on behalf of civil defense or other emergency agency.'
