STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Crop and Orchard Damage By Protected Wild Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 84, amended. The last sentence of the 3rd paragraph of section 84 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Said commissioner shall thereupon cause to be made such investigation as is necessary to determine the facts with the advice of the commissioner of agriculture, and, if he finds that damage has been done as alleged, he shall authorize payment for said damage.'
