RESOLVE, Providing for a Fish Screen at Outlet of Little Rattlesnake Pond in Town of Raymond, Cumberland County.

Outlet of Little Rattlesnake pond; screening of. Resolved: That the sum of \$500 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game, for installing a fish screen at the outlet of Little Rattlesnake pond in the town of Raymond, Cumberland county; provided, however that Archie F. Knapp, of Yarmouth, and Stephen W. Sawyer, of Portland, shall assume all liability for the maintenance of said screen and for keeping of said screen free from all sticks, leaves and debris so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same; and provided further that the state shall be liable for only $\frac{1}{2}$ the cost of said screen.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1949 the gate to the dam was lost and has been repaired temporarily. One of the engineers of the fish and game department has made an estimate of less than \$500 to replace the old gate. In the opinion of Mr. Knapp and Mr. Sawyer, and others, the fish screen can be put in at the same time and thereby save a great deal of money.
